Job Responsibilities:

Ensuring public safety

- Educate the public on water safety with a focus on accident prevention
- Respond to emergency situations and provide first aid within the scope of training
- Enforce and follow policies and procedures and adhere to Ontario Public Pool Regulations, including but not limited to: admission requirement standards and emergency procedures

Directly supervising the pool area

- Ability to work open shifts as early as 4:45a.m. would be considered an asset
- Continuous scanning of the pool and surrounding area including the deck and hot tub
- Enforce policies and procedures of aquatics facility
- Monitor participants in pool, identifying risks/hazards and associate good judgement

- Standard First Aid with CPR-C
